SAN JOSE COUNSELING PROGRAM/STUDENT OUTCOMES REPORT

The San Jose Counseling site welcomed a wonderful incoming class this fall along with our two full-time faculty members Dr. Judy Richards and Dr. Pali Gill. Dr. Richards is the San Jose Counseling Program Director. A strong group of continuing adjunct faculty members also support the program. Faculty are continuing to review curriculum to ensure an offering of the most up-to-date, integrative, clinically beneficial classes to prepare students effectively for practice and licensure.

In reviewing 2020-2021 data, the following points of information may be noted.

GRADUATES: 9 (summer, 2020 through spring, 2021, four from the new curriculum)

COMPLETION RATE: 88%

NCE/NCMHCE EXAMINATION PASS RATE: No students have attempted these exams this year

JOB PLACEMENT RATE OF GRADUATES: Of the four graduates from the new curriculum, two are Associate Professional Clinical Counselors in California.
