



Alumni Audit Opportunity

BENEFIT AND ELIGIBILITY:

Degree graduates of Western Seminary are invited to audit one course per year at no charge. Degree graduates include those who have completed a full master's or doctoral degree program.

REQUIREMENT:

The alumnus/a must complete a Non-Credit Application and Registration form each year and be granted admission. As an auditor, the alumnus/a's participation in class will follow that of all other non-credit students as outlined on the Non-Credit Application and Registration. The offer is for one qualifying course per academic year (September to September). In addition, the alumnus/a must complete this form for each course and return it with the application/registration form to have the scholarship applied to their account.

QUALIFYING COURSES:

The audit opportunity may be used for 500-level courses only. It may not be used for Th.M. 600-level courses, doctoral 700-level courses, or the following 500-level courses:

- Any counseling course (CNS or MFT) which is not available for audit
- Functional or traditional language courses (NTS or OTS)
- Courses in our ministry coaching studies (MCS) – exception: MCS 510 will be permitted
- Courses offered through the Center for Lifelong Learning (distance education)

For qualifying courses alumni should look at the official course schedule and find courses designated “open for audit” by the presence of the @ symbol which still meet the above restrictions.

In the rare case in which a course has a size limit, preference will be given to graduate credit students.

DOCTOR OF MINISTRY GRADUATES:

D.Min. graduates may audit one D.Min. class per year free of charge under this policy (in lieu of a 500-level course).
