

Western Seminary Guidelines for Readmission

NON-DEGREE: (not enrolled for 2 or 3 consecutive semesters) The student shall provide:
(1) Application for Re-admission

MASTER OF ARTS, MASTER OF DIVINITY, MASTER OF THEOLOGY:

One Year: (not enrolled for 2 or 3 consecutive semesters) The following shall be submitted:
(1) Application for re-admission; (2) one pastoral reference.

Two Years: (not enrolled for 4 to 6 consecutive semesters) The following shall be submitted:
(1) Application for re-admission; (2) one pastoral reference and one other reference

Three Years or More: (not enrolled for more than 6 consecutive semesters) The following shall be submitted: (1) New Application for Admission (located online and at the back of the Western Seminary catalog); (2) updated Christian experience statement; (3) three references; (6) official transcripts of any work taken since last enrolled at Western.

DOCTOR OF MINISTRY, DOCTOR OF MISSIOLOGY:

NOTES:

1. Filing the appropriate application materials does not guarantee re-admission to a degree program. The student must demonstrate that he/she still meets the admissions standards for that degree.
2. When a student withdraws for two or more consecutive semesters without prior written approval of the Admissions and Records office, he/she will re-enter under the current catalog rather than the one of initial admission.
3. If a student desires to re-enter the Seminary in a new degree program, he/she must satisfy the admission standards of the second degree.
