Analytical Key	<i>Scripture order</i> : parsing, brief definition	Use to get basic data on every Scripture word sidestepping knowing the root/dictionary form (generally multi-volume works since words can reappear hundreds of times vs. once as in the "alpha order" layout above)	<i>The new linguistic and exegetical key to the Greek New Testament</i>	Ref 225.48 Rog 14224
			<i>A linguistic key to the Greek New Testament</i>	Ref 225.4/8 Rie 12592
Parsing Guide	<i>Scripture order</i> : parsing, verbs only, no definitions	Use to parse verbs as they arise in Scripture, usually single volumes	<i>A parsing guide to the Greek New Testament</i>	Ref 225.48 Han 12593
Reader's Lexicon	<i>Scripture order</i> : brief definition of root words that are used less than 50 times; words used over 50 times are in an alpha index in the back	Use to define less-used words as they arise in Scripture; meant for Greek NT readers, i.e. enables one to read the Greek NT quickly with a single reference tool and no flipping pages, once one has a vocabulary up to words used 50 times or less	<i>A reader's Greek-English lexicon of the New Testament</i>	Ref 487.4 Kub 13086
Theological Dictionary/Wordbook	<i>Alpha order</i> : root/ dictionary forms, extended discussion of meanings	Use for in depth analysis of key words, usually multi-volume	<i>Theological dictionary of the New Testament</i> (10 vol.) (liberal)	Ref 487.3 Kit 11933
			<i>The New international dictionary of New Testament theology</i> (3 vol.) (conservative)	Ref 225/.3 Bro 12141

Concordance	<i>Scripture order</i> : brief listing of each Scripture phrase (in Greek) that includes the Greek word, usually categorizing the patterns regarding surrounding grammatical constructions	Use to establish the most precise word meanings possible, via the study of actual usage per specific authors and grammatical constructions		
Englishman's Concordance	<i>Scripture order</i> : brief listing of each Scripture phrase (using the KJV) that includes the Greek word	Use to establish relatively precise word meanings, via the study of actual usage per specific authors (grammatical patterns are lost via the use of English phrasing)	<i>The new Englishman's Greek concordance</i>	Ref 225.4/8 Wig 12736
Beginning Grammar		Use to understand rules of grammar and sentence construction	<i>Basics of biblical Greek : grammar</i>	Ref 487.4 Mou 14466
