

FACTS ABOUT THE EVENING SEMINARY

Western Seminary/Portland, Oregon

The Evening Seminary program provides graduate-level seminary education for those employed full-time or those who cannot attend daytime classes. The program is especially suited to those who must limit their attendance to evenings.

Distinctive Features

- Convenient study ... most classes meet one day a week
- Concentrated study ... classes meet 1-4 hours each class meeting
- Accessible education ... classes rotate so that required subjects are available to evening-only students.

Benefits to New Seminary Students

- Evening students may begin seminary on a trial, part-time basis.
- Evening students may complete a seminary degree while still holding a full-time day job.
- Evening students may enroll in all of the foundational subjects of the seminary: Bible, theology, biblical languages, pastoral ministry, intercultural studies, etc.

Benefits to Continuing Seminary Students

- Most foundational courses will be offered during a different semester than they normally are offered during the daytime. Students will have more choices for enrollment.
- Courses offered in the Evening Seminary may be applied toward M.Div., M.A., Graduate Studies Diploma and Graduate Studies Certificate programs.
- Two degree programs may be completed entirely through the Evening Seminary plus four Monday day courses:
 - M.Div. -- 4 years
 - M.A. (Biblical and Theological Studies) -- 4 years
 - M.A. in Ministry and Leadership – 4 years

Evening Seminary Class Schedule

- Monday and Thursday evenings
- Between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. (with two 10 minute breaks)

Tuition Costs

- \$425 per semester credit hour (\$850 for a 2 hour course; \$1700 for a 4 hour course)
- \$145 per audit hour (\$290 for a 2 hour course; \$580 for a 4 hour course); Coaching classes are \$325 per audit hour

To Register for an Evening Seminary Course

- Notify the Enrollment Office of your intent to enroll in a course. (New students complete a simple application.)
- Register for the course via SIS Online Registration. (Instructions provided to new students upon admission.)
- Pay for the course online, via telephone or in person the first week of the semester.
