Covers the disease, its victims, and counseling of all who are involved--victims & families. Recommended. Chr., WJU, BJW. (4,5,7)

- Arterburn, Stephen, Stoeker, Fred (with Mike Yorkey). Every Man=s Battle: Every Man=s Guide to Winning the War on Sexual Temptation One Victory at a Time. (The everyman series: sexual integrity). Colorado Springs, Colorado, 2000. This book is getting rave reviews by men. Comes with a workbook too. Covers topics like choosing true manhood, regaining what was lost, developing a battle plan, disciplining your mind and heart, and cherishing your wife. Chr. BJW, (8, 12).
- Arterburn, Stephen, Stoeker, Fred (with Mike Yorkey). Every Woman=s Desire: Every Man=s Guide to Winning the Heart of a Woman. (The everyman series: marital intimacy). Colorado Springs, Colorado, 2001. Good instruction for men on understanding and meeting a woman=s needs. Chr., (12).
- Arterburn, Stephen, Stoeker, Fred (with Mike Yorkey). Every Young Man=s Battle: Strategies for Victory in the Real World of Sexual Temptation. (The everyman series: sexual integrity). Colorado Springs, Colorado, 2002. This book is getting rave reviews by young men ages 15-18ish.. Covers topics like just being male, choosing authentic manhood, masturbation, developing your battle plan, sexual honor, and homosexual attraction. Chr., BJW, (3,4, 6, 12).
- Atkinson, David. Homosexuals in the Christian Fellowship. Grand Rapids: Wm. Eerdmans, 1979. Portrays the struggle in the church over homosexuality. Discusses current knowledge on homosexuality, the Biblical perspective going back to the Hebrew and Greek words. Uses extensive footnotes. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (4)
- Avna, Joan & Waltz, Diana. Celibate Wives: Breaking the Silence. Los Angeles, CA: Lowell House Books, 1994. An excellent resource for women whose husbands refuse a sexual relationship with them. Highly recommended. Sec., BJW. (7,8)
- Babbage, Stuart. Sex and Sanity. Philadelphia: Westminster Press, 1965. An Episcopal publication which discusses the body, sexuality, love, marriage, divorce, promiscuity, and homosexuality in a secular and Biblical sense. Chr., WJU. (1)
- Bainton, Roland. What Christianity Says About Sex, Love and Marriage. New York: Association Press, 1957. A brief history of love, sex, and marriage as seen through Christian historical periods. Chr., WJU. (1,14)
- Baker, Don. Beyond Rejection. Portland: Multnomah Press, 1985. This is the victorious story of Jerry, a homosexual man, and his wife as he struggles for freedom from homosexuality. It is a story that points out the need for the church to accept the homosexual and aid in healing. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (4)

- Balswick, J. & Balswick, J. Authentic Human Sexuality: An Integrated Christian Approach. Illinois: InterVarsity Press, 1999. An excellent volume dealing with numerous sexual issues from leading Christian authors. Recommended. Chr., BJW. (1, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10).
- Barbach, Lonnie. For Yourself: The Fulfillment of Female Sexuality. New York: New American Library, 1976. The book seeks to help women achieve orgasm. It has a detailed section on female sexual physiology--names, location and function of sexual parts. Many chapters devoted to achieving orgasm through masturbation. Recommended to the open minded with care. Sec., BJW. (2,3)
- Bass, Ellen and Laura Davis. The Courage to Heal. New York: Harper and Row, 1988. An excellent book which details the problems encountered by a woman survivor of child sexual abuse and the stages she will go through in healing. Extremely helpful for a person going through this process. It has a serious drawback for the Christian, however, in that the sexual morals, in particular homosexuality, are treated in a very liberal fashion. There are graphic stories of sex, including female homosexual relations. Recommended with cautions. Sec., WJU, BJW. (10)
- Bass, Ellen and Louise Thornton. I Never Told Anyone. New York: Harper and Row, 1983. Very graphic excerpts from stories of women who had been victims of child sexual abuse. They will jar your complacency and make you alternately sad and angry. Not everyone can or should read this book. Recommended with cautions. Sec., BJW, WJU. (10)
- Bell, Rob. Sex God: Exploring the Endless Connections between Sexuality and Spirituality. Zondervan, 2007. Chr., BJW (1).
- Betcher, William, M.D. Intimate Play: Creating Romance in Everyday Life. Viking, 1987. Discusses playfulness as it improves a couple's relationship. Sec., BJW. (8)
- Bird, Lewis and Christopher Reilly. Learning to Love. Waco: Word Publishing, 1971. Deals with contemporary sexual morality and its relationship to the church. Pros and cons of the church teaching sex education. Biblical perspective on sex. Suggests courses for junior and senior high student. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (12)
- Blitchington, W. Peter. Sex Roles and the Christian Family. Wheaton: Tyndale, 1981. The emphasis of this book is the development of male and female identity and sex roles in the family. It is written from a conservative Biblical perspective, stressing the separateness of the two sexes both in identity and roles. Emphasizes the danger of homosexuality, divorce, and promiscuity. Contains ten principles in counseling homosexuals, facts about homosexuality, suggestions for the counselor, advice to the homosexual and some testimonies of healed homosexuals. Recommended. - Brownmiller, Susan. Against Our Will. Toronto: Bantam Books, 1975. Factual information on the history of rape especially as it relates to war and mob violence. Covers prison homosexual rape and child sexual abuse. It has a discussion of the victims, the setting and what happened to them. Concludes with a section on women fighting back. Sec., BJW. (10)
- Burgen, Jim. What's the Big Deal about Sex: Loving God's Way. Cincinnati, Ohio: Standard Publishing, 1999. Addressed to a teen audience. Includes discussion of subjects like: why wait, how do I wait, masturbation, homosexuality, interracial dating, and what if I've already messed up. Chr., (3, 4, 5, 6, 12)

- Coleman, Barry, Editor. Sex and the Single Christian. Ventura: Regal Books, 1985. Contains "candid conversations" with various contemporary Christians on sex for the single person. - Collins, Gary, editor. The Secrets of Our Sexuality. Waco: Word Publishing, 1976. Covers a variety of topics by various contemporary authors. Topics include men and women's gender roles, sexual counseling, homosexuality and sex education. - Cutrer, William, M.J. D. & Glahn, Sandra. Sexual Intimacy in Marriage. Rand Rapids, Michigan: Kregel Publications, 2001. A good basic manual for married couples. Chr. (12).
- Dallas, Joe. A Strong Delusion: Confronting the Gay Christian Movement. Harvest House Publishers, 1996. Helps the reader learn to respond to the key arguments in the pro gay Christian movement. Highly recommended. Chr., BJW. (4)
- Dallas, Joe. Desires in Conflict. Harvest House Publishers, 1991. A Christian who tried to live out his faith while practicing a homosexual lifestyle, Dallas articulates well the struggle. Chr. (4).
- Daniel, Eleanor. What the Bible Says About Sexual Identity. Joplin: College Press Publishing Co., 1981. Covers development of sexual identity from birth through development to marriage. Also covers theology, divorce, adultery, deviations, and singleness. The chapter on singleness seems to be one of the best chapters in the book. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (6,11)
- Davies, Bob & Lori Rentzel. Coming Out of Homosexuality: New Freedom for Men and Women. Downers Grove, Illinois: InterVarsity Press, 1993. Covers steps to freedom. Very practical treatment of breaking addictive patterns. Recommended. Chr., BJW. (4)

- Davis, Michele. The Sex-Starved Marriage: Boosting your Marriage Libido. New York, NY. Simon & Schuster, 2003. One of only a few resources to help couples struggling with limited/celebrate sex lives. Sec., BJW. (7, 8, 12).
- Dillow, Joseph C. Solomon on Sex: A Biblical Guide to Married Love. Nashville: Thomas Nelson Publishing, 1977. Excellent commentary on the Song of Solomon. Dillow views hierarchy as God's design for men and women. Appendix includes questionable treatment of sexual dysfunction. Recommended. Chr., WJU, BJW. (1)
- Dillow, Linda & Pintus, Lorraine. Intimate Issues: 21 Questions Women Ask About Sex. Colorado Springs, Colorado, 1999. Written to the married Christian woman addressing questions like, can you be sensuous and Godly? What does God think about sex? It also deals with practical questions like What do I do when I don't want to do it? Chr. (12)
- Dobson, James. Love Must Be Tough: New Hope for Families in Crisis. Waco: Word Books, 1983. Excellent discussion of adultery and the principle involved in dealing with it. Recommended. Chr., WJU, BJW. (5)
- Dobson, James. What Wives Wish Their Husbands Knew About Women. Wheaton: Tyndale, 1975. Discusses sexual problems in marriage, menstrual, and physiological difficulties. Also has chapters on low self-esteem, fatigue and time problems, loneliness, and boredom. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (7)

- Dwyer, John C. Human Sexuality: A Christian View. Kansas City, MO: Sheed and Ward, 1987. An interesting philosophical commentary on sexuality. Deals with a wide range of dimensions of sexuality. Unique are the inclusions of responses to Catholic church doctrine on marriage, birth control, celibacy. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (1)
- Edwards, Gene. The Divine Romance. Auburn, Maine: Christian Books Publishing House, 1934. An account of human creation. Recommended. Chr., BJW. (4)
- Ellens, Harold. Sex in the Bible: A New Consideration. Praeger, 2007. A discussion/evaluation of the Bible and its teachings on love, marriage, and sexuality. It includes controversial issues like homosexuality and polygamy. Chr. BJW (1).
- Ells, Alfred. Restoring Innocence: Healing the Memories and Hurts that Hinder Sexual Intimacy. Nashville: Thomas Nelson, 1990. This book helps those who have been sexually harmed, deal with the memories and hurts that get in the way of true sexual intimacy. Recommended. (10)
- Fischer, Helen. Anatomy of Love: A Natural History of Mating, Marriage, and Why We Stray. New York, NY: Fawcett Books, 1992. Recommended. Sec., BJW, (14).
- Fischer, Helen. Why We Love: The Nature and Chemistry of Romantic Love. New York, NY: Henry Holt & Co., 2004. Recommended. Sec., BJW. (2)
- Flatt, Bill W., Jack P. Lewis, & Dowell E. Flatt. Counseling Homosexuals. Jonesboro: National Christian Press, 1982. Contains detailed word studies of the Hebrew and Greek in the context of passages of the Old and New Testaments relating to homosexuality. A third chapter covers counseling homosexuals. Recommended. Chr. (4)
- Fortunato, John. AIDS, the Spiritual Dilemma. San Francisco: Harper and Row, 1987. Discusses the church and its relationship with homosexuality, the dilemma of the gay people, why AIDS has stirred up strong feelings. Covers dealing with the pain and despair of AIDS. Written as a gay who counsels gays, including those with AIDS to challenge the church. A liberal view. Chr., BJW. (4,7)
- Foster, Richard. Money, Sex, and Power. San Francisco: Harper and Row, 1985. An excellent, though short, overview of a Christian perspective of sexuality. In this section the author covers Old Testament and New Testament theology, and the church's views on sex. Also includes distorted sexuality, singleness, masturbation, and the covenant relationship in marriage. Recommended. Chr., BJW. (1)
- Frank, Jan. A Door of Hope. San Bernardino: Here's Life Publishing, 1987. A step by step healing process for victims of child sexual abuse beginning with facing the problem to restoration. Covers dealing with feelings, confronting the aggressor, forgiveness, and rebuilding yourself. It is full of Scriptures and has a strong emphasis on the work of God. Recommended. Chr., WJU. (10)

- Friberg, Nils, and Laaser, Mark. Before the Fall: Preventing Pastoral Sexual Abuse. Liturgical Press, 1998. Laaser was a pastor who abused. He=s well qualified to suggest danger signals and provide helpful advice on catching the problem before it develops. Chr. (10)
- Freeman, D'Emilio and Estelle. Intimate Matters: A History of Sexuality in America. New York: Harper & Row, 1988. A scholarly work--includes the rise and fall of sexual liberalism to the present. Includes discussions of race, class, and gender as it relates to sexuality. Sec., BJW. (14)

- Gagnon, Robert. The Bible and Homosexual Practice: Texts and Hermeneutics. Nashville, TN: Abingdon Press, 2001. A through analysis of biblical texts relating to homosexuality. His clearly articulated argument establishes that the Bible unanimously defines same-sex intercourse as sin. Chr., BJW. (1, 4).

He uses Scriptures liberally to emphasize what he is saying. Recommended. Chr. (10)
- Wilson, Earl D. Counseling and Homosexuality. Waco: Word Publishing, 1988. Discusses what homosexuality is, theories of how people become homosexual, and current controversies surrounding it. He discusses basically how to counsel male and female homosexuals including giving various models to employ. There are chapters on AIDS and dealing with homophobia. There is much information on what kind of reactions the counselor may experience in himself and how to deal with them. It is conservative in its Biblical standards, yet loving in its attitude. Recommended: a good basic book. Chr., BJW. (4)
- Wilson, Earl. Sexual Sanity. Downer's Grove: IVP, 1984. Shows problems which arise from use of pornography and how it feeds other obsessions. Poor coverage of homosexuality. Discusses facing temptation and overcoming obsessions. Generally good. Chr., WJU. (9)
