

BENEFIT AND ELIGIBILITY

A 20 percent tuition scholarship is awarded to graduates of a Western Seminary degree program who have been admitted to the Doctor of Ministry or Doctor of Intercultural Studies program. This scholarship will be for credit courses which meet degree program requirements. The scholarship does not include costs for fees, books, living expenses, repeated courses, or courses which do not meet degree program requirements.

Doctoral students may not stack financial aid grants in excess of 20 percent of their tuition costs. The usual seminary policy prohibiting students with past due accounts from registering for subsequent courses will be followed. While it is Western Seminary's intention to honor this tuition scholarship through a student's entire program (subject to limitations outlined above), we reserve the right to adjust or discontinue this tuition scholarship if necessary.

REQUIREMENT

Students must be admitted into either the Doctor of Ministry or Doctor of Intercultural Studies program. It is expected that a student will meet all of the requirements of his or her program as outlined in the program handbook and Academic Catalog.
