




HISTORY OF WESTERN SEMINARY

Portland Baptist Bible Institute was organized in the winter of 1925, and the Western Baptist Theological Seminary was officially dedicated on October 4, 1927 to provide a theological education of greater depth in the Northwestern United States. Though its name has changed to Western Seminary, its focus continues to be on teaching a conservative and evangelical Christian doctrine, with a progressive philosophy of ministry in and alongside the Church.

Western Seminary has opened several extension campus locations in the Western United States to support residential studies in other major cities. The seminary came to Sacramento in 1991 subsequent to launching in San Jose in 1986.

After small beginnings, Western Seminary Sacramento Campus has grown to host over 100 students this past academic year. We thank you for participating today in our Fourteenth Annual Commencement. It is because of your support for these pastors, counselors, missionaries, chaplains, teachers, and more, that we are able to celebrate their accomplishments and futures today.

Commencement marks a significant milestone in these graduates' journeys, as they continue as new alumni equipped for gospel-centered ministry. Having passionately served our Lord during their experience at Western, they move into the future better equipped to meet the challenges of ministry before them. PURPOSE STATEMENT

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The tradition of academic dress began centuries ago in chilly universities where cap, gown and hood were needed for covering and warmth. Subsequently, this has become a ceremonial costume with certain standardized features.

Sleeves in the bachelor's gown are pointed; in the master's gown, oblong with arms projecting at the elbow; in the doctor's gown, bell-shaped. The doctor's gown is faced with velvet with three matching stripes on the sleeves, and the hood is lined with the official colors of the degree-conferring institution.

Western Seminary's school colors are blue and gold. Graduates in Biblical and Theological Studies, Ministry and Leadership, and Divinity will receive a hood with red trim, while graduates in Counseling and Marital and Family Therapy will receive a hood with white trim.



Steve Korch, D.Min. 1950-2021

Dr. Steve Korch went to be with Jesus in January of 2021 after having served faithfully from 1998-2020. He first came to Western as a student, earning his Master of Divinity in 1978 and later his Doctor of Ministry in 2011. After more than twenty years, he served as an adjunct faculty member, Executive Dean in San Jose, and for the last ten years as Associate Professor of Pastoral Ministry at both California campuses. He taught many courses and wrote numerous books on the topics of spiritual formation and pastoral theology. He is survived by his wife Ruthie, three children, and seven grandchildren.

Kristen Williams was set to walk with the graduating class of 2021, but the Lord took her home in December of 2020. Words fail to capture the spirit and life Kristen brought to the campus while she pursued her M.A. in Counseling and Addiction Studies Certificate. As she left an imprint on many through her ministry to her family, church, and everyone who met her, she did the same with fellow students, faculty, and staff at Western Seminary. Today receiving her diploma is her husband of 27 years, David Williams. We count it a joy despite the sadness in our hearts to remember and celebrate Kristen this day.

VERSE 2


In Christ alone who took on flesh

Here in the death of Christ I live


VERSE 3 (GRADUATES ONLY)
