#### WOULD YOUR SPOUSE LIKE TO AUDIT A COURSE WITH YOU?

Don't forget! Your spouse is invited to join you in your education at Western! Spouses of students enrolled in a master's program are invited to audit one course per semester, and a special scholarship may apply. The regular audit rate is \$75 per audit hour, however, spouses of students enrolled in 8+ credits will receive a 75% scholarship toward the class they audit, and spouses of students enrolled in 4-7 credits will receive a 50% scholarship.
