## **Job Opportunity**

#### **Student Services Associate**

This position is 32 hours/week M-F, but may include some evening and Saturday hours. Responsible for providing administrative and programmatic support to students throughout their seminary training, of which 8 hours/week minimum will be directly supporting the students in the Marital and Family Therapy program.

#### **REGISTRATION CONTINUES**

Open Registration for the Fall 2017 semester has closed but you may still add or drop classes. If you are a returning student and you registered for at least one class by July 31 you will not be charged the one-time \$50 late registration fee and there is no charge to add additional classes before the semester starts. Incoming and new students have until the first week of classes to register. (Audit participants: please review S.I.S. for audit class registration and fees.) The Fall 2017 Courses and Semester Class Schedule and San Jose Campus Syllabi should be posted.

#### **TUITION & FEE RATES + RESOURCES**

New tuition rates and fees are in place for 2017-2018 (tuition and fee sched-

ule). There is a modest tuition increase (now Credit: \$565/hr, Audit: \$100/ hr, and Audit Coaching classes: \$415/ hr). More information can be found on the Seminary Tuition and Fees page. Students in degree programs who are registered for at least one course for credit each term will also be charged a \$220 Education Resource Fee per semester. A few of the new resources you will receive include: access to Logos Bible Software (and you get to keep it when you graduate), additional electronic resources in Western's library, and "SNAP," and a new student/advisor communication tool coming this fall. Those who have already purchased Logos, will receive a reimbursement on their account. Separate lab fees will no longer be charged for language courses.

Beginning with the fall 2017 semester, the tuition due date will be due the Friday before the semester begins. The fall semester begins on September 2; tuition is due September 1.

TuitionPay allows you to break your tuition up into 4 equal payments. Payment months for the Fall Semester are August through November. Enroll here.

#### **2017-2018 GRADUATES**

Students planning to graduate in the fall of 2017 need to turn in their Application to Graduate ASAP. Spring and summer graduates have a November 15th submission deadline. 
