October 4th, 2017 was the 90th birthday of Western Baptist Theological Seminary, AKA Western Conservative Baptist Theological Seminary, AKA Western Conservative Baptist Seminary, AKA Western Seminary. Western Seminary opened its doors in 1927 at Hinson Memorial Church (Eastside Baptist then) in Oregon. Then the seminary moved down to Salmon Street before moving up on Mt. Tabor.

Since then, the San Jose campus, Sacramento campus, Seattle teaching site, and Online campus were launched.

Welcome, Dr. Val Andrews!

We are pleased to announce that Dr. Valerie Andrews (AKA Dr. Val Richards) has agreed to serve as the Director of the Marital and Family Therapy program at the San Jose Campus. Her first day was Monday, October 2. She will be working a total of 24 hours a week (3-4 days on campus), and teaching around 10-12 credits a year. Dr. Val has been a long-time part-time adjunct faculty at Western Seminary since 2003, primarily teaching at the San Jose campus. She has also taught a little at the Sacramento Campus. Dr. Val brings a PhD in Clinical Psychology (emphasis on Neuropsychology) from the Pacific Graduate School of Psychology (now called Palo Alto University). Her specialties include child psychology, trauma, and addictions. She recently moved from Colorado where her work was centered on addictions. Earlier, she was recruited to work in New Zealand for several years after leaving the San Jose area in 2011.

Dr. Val has been making her rounds to the counseling classes to introduce herself to the students and adjuncts. You may have seen her around offering yummy pumpkin treats and hugs. It is already evident that she is passionate about building a stronger community and serving our counseling students and faculty well.
