A highlight in 2016 has been the CACREP accreditation extension until 2023 with the notation that all standards have been met. We formed an Advisory Board which included clinical mental health counselor clinicians, counselor educators, and administrators from Western and from the community at large. Based upon data submitted and recommendations from the Advisory Board we have implemented a number of positive changes.
